This significant investment will allow Canada to tackle emerging challenges, including greater emphasis on better reaching children in the fragile first month of life, stepping up immunization efforts, enhancing efforts on nutrition and building civil registration and vital statistics systems to improve accountability for results and as a passport to a child's rights.

Canada wishes you a successful launch and we look forward to the continued success of the Every Woman Every Child movement as you continue to galvanize action and seek new innovative opportunities to ensure we assist countries to attain their health goals.
